PEDORTHICS AT BAKER COLLEGE OF FLINT

Baker College's Pedorthics program combines online education with hands-on training taught in a state-of-the-art facility.

This noncredit course provides 150 hours of instruction (70 hours online and 80 hours oncampus).

Participants will study human anatomy, pathology, biomechanics, and evaluation of medical conditions that originate at or below the ankle.

Also included in the course are lower-limb orthotic design, materials used for orthotic and prosthetic modification, footwear fitting, and patient and practice management.
