










Hosmer announces the release of the new Soft Voluntary Closing Hand.  This hand, along with its counterpart the Soft Voluntary Opening Hand  have undergone extensive testing and have evolved into the current patient focused design. These lightweight, rugged, low maintenance hands are constructed with a tough nylon frame and are available in 3 sizes: 7-1/4, 7-3/4, and 8-1/4. The SVC and SVO hands have pliable finger pads and can be ordered with a dorsal  or a palmer  cable exit.

The Soft Voluntary Closing Hand features a more physiologic grip, allowing the patient to graduate  the pinch force. The reciprocating grip lock is easy to set and can be activated in any position which permits the handling of a wide variety of objects and repetitive movements. 

The Soft Voluntary Opening Hand can be used in almost any environment and can maintain the grip longer.  Because of the similar operations, Hosmer's SVO hand is best for Transhumeral wearers and is ideal for someone switching from a hook  to a hand.
