

VICTOR'S PATIENT INSPIRED SOLUTION

Victor was diagnosed with global brachial plexus injury at birth. At 4 months of age, Victor had primary nerve surgery and at 18 months, arthroscopic reduction of the left shoulder. Botulinum toxin was used at 18 months and 24 months to increase range. At 30 months, Victor was fitted with an Ultraflex dynamic assist EO with the goals of gaining back lost range, improving positioning and cosmesis. At 36 months, Victor has gained back his range with near 60° degrees of flexion, has outstanding compliance (wears his Ultraflex orthosis 22 hours per day for stretching and functional positioning for daytime activities) and has awareness of his arm and hand — using his left hand as a helper hand. Mom reports: "Playing and eating is where the biggest difference is noticed."
